

## **README**

This CD contains data on Primary Census Abstract based on information collected during 2001 Census in India.

### **Minimum system requirement**

Pentium 1 or above, 32 MB RAM, 32x CD-ROM drive, 800x600 video display, sound card, speaker. Win97 or above, MS Office 97 or above (required to export files in excel files), Adobe acrobat reader (required to view portable document format files).

### **Installation:**

Read the following instructions for quick software installation:

1. Insert CD in CD-Rom drive, it will run automatically. If not, click [start->Run and then type x:\main.exe where x:\ is the CD Drive on your machine](#) or explore CD drive and double click on main.exe
2. Census signature tune will run and finally the animation stops and would prompt for the following:
  - a) **Install software for Window:** Click this button and follow wizard instructions to install software on your computer. It will create an icon on your computer desktop and will also add a group in your computer Start program section. After installation, restart windows once and double click on your desktop icon or start using software from Start program menu option.
  - b) **Install Acrobat Reader:** You can install this software on your computer to view portable format documents (PDF) files, which is provided in this CD.
  - c) **Readme:** The current write up explaining the contents
3. After the installation is finished, double click on the PCA CD icon shortcut created on your computer desktop and start using the software.

### **Salient features of this software:**

This software CD provides the table on the Primary Census Abstract as per 2001 Census. Many user-friendly features have been included in this CD to allow the data user to explore the data from different sides. The data is made available by state, district, sub-district, town, village and ward in town.

The data is being presented in the following sections:

#### **1. Population**

- a) Population by sex and sex ratio
- b) Total population, Scheduled Castes and Schedule Tribes population and their proportion to total population
- c) Population in the age group (0-6 years) and sex ratio (0-6)
- d) Number of households, population and household size

#### **2. Literacy**

- a) Distribution of population among literates and illiterates
- b) Number of literates and literacy rate by sex
- c) Literacy rate by sex and gender gap in literacy rate

**3. Workers**

- a) Distribution of population by worker and non-worker
- b) Number of workers and work participation rate by sex
- c) Distribution of total workers by main workers and marginal workers category
- d) Percentage distribution of total workers and by main and marginal category
- e) Distribution of total workers by category
- f) Distribution of total workers by category in percentage
- g) Distribution of main workers by category of worker
- h) Distribution of main workers by category of worker in percentage
- i) Distribution of marginal workers by category of worker
- j) Distribution of marginal workers by category of worker in percentage

Population and sex ratio among Scheduled Castes (SC) and Scheduled Tribes (ST)

**5. Area Profile**

This section allows user to generate information about the selected place (i.e. state/district/sub-district/towns/villages or ward in towns) on various indicators as well as derived variables along with map (up to sub-district level only). Facility of printing the Area Profile for record has also been provided.

**6. Choose indicators**

This section provides facility to generate tables on the basis of indicators and level as decided by the data user. The final table so generated may also be exported to Excel or HTML formats.

**7. Village summary**

In this section summary data (bar chart and tables) on no of villages is being provided in the following tables:
