ABSTRACT

Ministry of Health and Family Welfare launched the National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) to ensure necessary architectural corrections in the basic health care delivery system. The plan of action includes: increasing public expenditure on health, reducing regional imbalance in health infrastructure, pooling resources, integration of organizational structures, optimization of health manpower, decentralization and district management of health programmes, community participation and ownership of assets, induction of management and financial personnel into district health systems, and operationalizing community health centers into functional hospitals in each block across the country that meet Indian public health standards.

These interventions have increased the demand for data on population and health for use in both micro-level planning and programme

implementation. At the same time, understanding the synergy between availability of services, cost involved in provision of public health care services, expenditure and pattern of utilization among various sections of population, including vulnerable sections of the society, are important aspects that influence decision making. A continuous flow of good quality information on inputs, outputs and outcome indicators facilitates monitoring of the objectives of nrhm.

For reasons such as these efficient health management information systems are required. Health Management Information System (HMIS) is an information system that has been specially designed to assist health departments, at all levels, in managing and planning health programmes. Hmis is defined as a tool which helps in gathering, aggregating, analyzing and then using the information generated for taking actions to improve performance of health systems.
